The Association for International Exchange of Japanese Music has decided to implement the above project.

Independent Administrative Agency, Japan Arts Council has launched a new project to support the development of young creators and artists. We, the Association for International Exchange of Japanese Music applied for this project and accepted in September 2024. Based on this result, we are planning the following activities from 2024 to 2026.

■ Outline of the Activities

We will form a diverse network and develop a training program through lectures and practices under the guidance of instructors with extensive experience in overseas performances.

■ Target fields, performance programs, activity plan

(1) Sankyoku performers team

Performance program: Classic pieces from the Ikuta school and the Yamada school,
Contemporary pieces and newly commissioned pieces

Activity plan: Lectures and discussions, workshop and concerts in Japan,
workshop and concerts in France and in Germany

(2) Gagaku performers team

Performance program: Classic Gagaku pieces, Contemporary pieces and newly commissioned pieces

Activity plan: Lectures and discussions, workshop and concerts in Japan,
workshop and concerts in Vietnam and Indonesia

(3) Hogaku Neo Ensemble team

Performance program: Contemporary pieces and newly commissioned pieces

Activity plan : Lectures and discussions, workshop and concerts in Japan,
workshop and concerts in the United States of America

(4) Management and publicity team

Activity plan: Lectures and discussions, producing and advertising concerts and workshops for the three teams, photographic and video records of this project.
